The goal of this merit badge is to make scouts more aware of the ideals, history, and purposes of organized labor. This is accomplished through discussions of labor terms, labor issues, and labor history and through games, demonstrations, and role play exercises that help the scouts understand the workings of labor negotiations.

The seminar will be presented in two Saturday morning sessions on September 18,2010 and on October 09, 2010 from 9:00 a.m. until 12:30 . Attendance at both sessions will be required to complete the merit badge requirements and receive the merit badge. These sessions will be held at the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers hiring hall located at 5179 Fishwick Dr. Suite 102. (Take I-75 or Paddock Rd. To Towne St. , turn onto Fishwick Dr. And immediately turn right into driveway. IBEW hall is at end of driveway.)

Merit Badge Booklets will be distributed to each participant at the first session to help with the requirements.

Participants will be limited to the first 30 registrations, please register as soon as possible.
